






NHBC – A Brief History

- Government of the day were supportive - providing it was not a 'Builders Club'






NHBC Virtuous Circle




New home volumes






Volumes

Starts - 3 month volumes









CH4.1 – Land Quality

Appendix 4.1-D "Suitable persons" and "consultants or specialists" SUITABLE PERSONS



The following skills and knowledge are required by the person responsible for the Initial Assessment (<u>Clause D3</u>), Basic Investigation (<u>Clause D4</u>) and Documentation and Verification (<u>Clause D7</u>):

- be able to carry out a desk study and walkover survey
- understand the hazards that can affect the development and know from where they originate
- know how to collect information relating to such hazards on and adjacent to the site
- be able to recognise the signs of potential hazards
- be able to determine when specialist advice and detailed testing is required, and
- be able to report the findings in a clear and concise manner.
